



Online/Blended Learning

The Blended Learning Courses offer the convenience of online training in combination with skills sessions coordinated with the American Red Cross Badger Chapter. The first portion of the course, including the written exam, is online and can be taken from any computer with Internet access. The second part of the training, the skill practice and assessment, is conducted by a Red Cross instructor in a classroom setting. Red Cross Blended Learning is flexible, self-paced and available online 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Students have the option of going through the lessons in a full or abbreviated format and can test out of lessons. Web-based training enables course-takers to access courses at their convenience and minimizes schedule conflicts with work-related responsibilities. Classes may include Adult, Child, Infant CPR, First Aid and Adult or Child AED. Interested individuals must have access to a high speed computer to complete the online portion. Please allow a maximum of 4 weeks between the online session and skills portion of the training. Supported Operating Systems: Windows 2000, XP, or Vista. Internet Browsers: IE 6.0 or higher, Firefox 2.0 or higher.

Adult CPR/First Aid

Cost: \$57.00

This course covers Adult CPR, included respiratory and cardiac emergencies, and an overview of first aid. Adult CPR/AED/First Aid

Cost: \$62.00

This course gives knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide care for breathing emergencies, perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), and learn how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED) for victims of sudden cardiac arrest. In addition, this course trains individuals to become familiar in how to recognize and care for victims of injuries and sudden illness. **Online Session: Approx 3 hours. Skills Practice and Assessment: Approx 2 1/2 hours Certification(s) Received:** Adult CPR and AED (valid for one-year) AND First Aid (valid for three-years)

Adult CPR and AED/Child and Infant CPR/First Aid

Cost: \$72.00

This course gives individuals the knowledge and skills necessary to recognize and provide basic care for breathing and cardiac emergencies in adults, children and infants until advanced medical personnel come and take over as well as an overview of first aid. Individuals will also learn how to provide care for an adult in sudden cardiac arrest through the safe use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). Skills covered include controlling bleeding; caring for muscle, bone and joint injuries; treating burns; and responding to shock. **Online Session: Approx 2-4 hours. Skills Practice and Assessment: Approx 4 hours Certifications Received:** Adult CPR/Child CPR/ Infant CPR and Adult AED(valid for one-year) and First Aid (valid for three years.)
