

Program Description

The Badger Chapter Disaster Partners Program is designed for organizations like yours. As a passionate supporter of the Chapter's disaster relief efforts, this is an opportunity to provide continuous, long-term financial support for local disaster relief.

- To become a partner, an initial contribution is made to the Badger Chapter. To maintain Partnership, subsequent annual contributions will be made on the anniversary of the first contribution. Contribution levels range from a lead gift of \$30,000 to a minimum gift of \$2,500.
- Partner contributions will be used for Chapter disaster relief efforts only. Your contribution will be used to pay for immediate assistance for individuals and families impacted by disaster. This assistance may include shelter, food, clothing, medical supplies, and counseling. If contributions are not exhausted by disaster relief assistance, remaining funds will be used to support the delivery of disaster assistance.
- Current Partners will assist the Chapter in actively recruiting new Partners. The Chapter will provide recruiting materials for the Partners to use.
- If a very large disaster (e.g., 2008 Wisconsin Floods or Hurricane Katrina) occurs, the Chapter will contact Partners for additional contributions as part of the Chapter's Disaster Fundraising Plan, which is automatically activated by a large disaster.
- Reporting to Partners will consist of a quarterly report and will include chapter disaster statistics for the previous quarter, new Disaster Partners, an update on Partner recruitment progress, and the status of disaster expenses.
